**Campbell Park in Milton Keynes, in addition to providing a public amenity area for the local population, is the site for many of the town's open-air events ranging from shows and competitions to fairs and circuses.**

When the decision was made in 1996/97 to prepare a specific events area within the park, Milton Keynes Park Trust investigated all the options available, including a number of "reinforced grass" products.

The Netlon Advanced Turf System, although not the cheapest, was selected as the preferred option and was installed in October, 1997. ATS was chosen because it offered a surface which was free-draining, safe for the public and could be used by traffic, including HGVs, in all weather.

The actual events area measured 7,690 m<sup>2</sup> and a 200mm thick layer of Netlon ATS was laid over a reinforced, free-draining sub-base. Appropriate drains were installed beneath the sub-base.

Since its completion, the Campbell Park events area has successfully hosted a large number of events - ranging from giant fairgrounds to city spectaculars. It has even been put to test as a landing area by one of the Royal Flight Helicopters.
